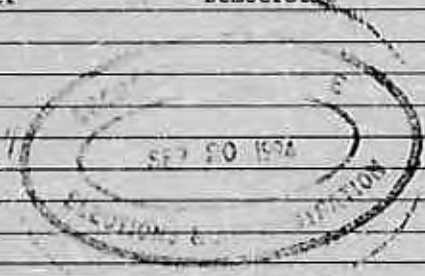

- Orwell - There is a discrepancy of one vote: total is 39, should be 38. Town Clerk was contacted, had no explanation.

The committee does not feel that the above discrepancies affect the vote results, but are significant enough to be noted.
