PROPOSAL 7

To see if the voters will amend the Vermont Constitution by amending § 40 of Chapter II to read:
§ 40. (EXCESSIVE BAIL PROHIBITED; PRISONERS BAILABLE; IMPRISONMENT FOR DEBT PROHIBITED)
Excessive bail shall not be exacted for bailable offenses. All persons, except persons charged with offenses punishable by death or life imprisonment, who are arrested or imprisoned for offenses punishable by death or life imprisonment shall be released from custody on reasonable bail.
(1) A person accused of an offense punishable by death or life imprisonment may be held without bail.
(2) A person accused of a felony, an offense punishable by death or life imprisonment, or a person charged with an offense punishable by death or life imprisonment shall be held without bail unless the court finds, based upon clear and convincing evidence, that there is a substantial risk to the safety of the community if the person is released on bail.

To see if the voters will amend the Vermont Constitution by adding a new § 76 to Chapter II to read:
§ 76. JUDICIAL LANGUAGE REVISIONS
The Judges of the Superior Court are hereby authorized and directed to recast Chapter II of the Constitution in order to clarify language. This revision shall be subject to the approval of the Legislature. When the revision is completed, the text of the Constitution shall be printed in the State of Vermont.
EFFECTIVE DATE: The revision and certification shall be completed by the Supreme Court no later than January 1, 1997.
