NOTES:

- PrKey -- Voter registration based upon the number of citizens who are included on a checklist on file with their town or city clerk a certain number of days before the primary election.
- PrAct -- The actual number of voters who showed at the polls on election day based upon the number of names checked on the checklists used at the polling places. This figure includes the number of voters who voted by absentee ballots as well.
- PrPds -- The actual number of absentee ballots counted on election day.
- PrT08 -- Voter turnout based upon the percentage of voters registered to vote in this election who actually did show at the polls and cast a ballot.
- \$StKey -- An estimated percentage of the actual voters who cast ballots in the Republican Primary. This is based upon the highest vote total for all offices in the Primary.
- \$Dem -- An estimated percentage of the actual voters who cast ballots in the Democratic Primary.
- \$LU -- An estimated percentage of the actual voters who cast ballots in the Liberty Union Primary.
- GnKey, GnAct, GnGds, and GnT08 are used in the same manner as their counterparts explained above but for the general election rather than the primary.
- \$StKey -- The proportion of the total state registered voters generated by the unit listed, i.e., county or town, expressed as a percentage of the state total.
- Reg Gain/Loss -- These last two columns list the voter registration for the immediately preceding general election with the gain or loss of registered voters listed as a percentage of the unit total for the preceding general election.
- * Dem Towns -- There were 8 towns wherein the most ballots were cast in the Democratic Primary.
